

Did you know that parking on all Centerville streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. is prohibited? Did you know that City Hall issues free parking permits for little to no inconvenience on your part? All it takes is a visit to City Hall to obtain the permit itself. You can either call us or appear in person with the following information: registered owner, address of where the vehicle(s) will be parked, license plate #, year, make, model and color of the vehicle(s).

Please think ahead! City Hall hours are Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., unless in recognition of a legal holiday. Please consider alternative options if City Hall is closed and you need a permit; such as parking in a neighbor's driveway, parking in your garage, temporarily parking along the side of your garage, etc. If you anticipate overnight guests but do not have a clue as to the City's required information for their vehicle(s), provide us with your vehicle information and park your vehicle(s) in the street with a temporary permit.

Hindering street parking is for your safety! Vehicle(s) are not abandoned on your streets; residents and guests of residents are in the neighborhood during 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. and should be the only ones parked in the street; public safety/emergency medical vehicle(s)' accessibility; and during the winter, street maintenance services.
