A RESOLUTION ADOPTING BUDGET AND TAX LEVIES FOR 2017

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, a public meeting to obtain input on the 2017 City Budget and tax levy was held by the City Council of the City of Centerville.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Centerville, County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, that the City Budget for 2017 is hereby adopted as follows:

General Fund \$2,630,423

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following sums of money be levied for property taxes payable in 2017 upon the taxable property in the City of Centerville for the following purposes:

General Fund Levy \$2,158,621

Debt Service Levy:

Debt Service 2012A Bonds \$ 70,000
Debt Service 2009A Bonds \$ 185,000
Debt Service 2011A Bonds \$ 273,000
Debt Service 2013A Bonds \$ 17,900

Total Debt Service Levy \$ 545,900

Total Levy \$2,704,521

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that scheduled debt service payments are funded through other revenue sources in addition to the above debt service levies, and the corresponding levy amounts varying from the above debt service levies are hereby waived.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby instructed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of Anoka County, Minnesota along with all required documentation.


