

Did you know that parking on all Centerville streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. is prohibited? You will need a printer and the following information: registered owner, address of where the vehicle(s) will be parked, license plate #, year, make, model and color of the vehicle(s). Just make sure you print before you submit. When you print, make sure you print just page 1 as page 2 is not needed. Page 1 will be placed on the dash of the vehicle that will be parked in the roadway for the duration of the period (not to exceed 10 days) during the hours of 3:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m.

The City does have some suggestions if you have late notice guests, no access to a printer, etc. Ask a neighbor if a vehicle can be parked in their driveway overnight, temporarily park a vehicle along-side of your garage, park a vehicle in your garage, etc.

Hindering street parking is for your safety! Assisting in ensuring that vehicle(s) are not abandoned on your streets; vehicles leaking fluids are not parked on the street rather than in resident driveway(s), residents and guests of residents are in the neighborhood during 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. and should be the only ones parked in the street; public safety/emergency medical vehicle(s)' accessibility; and during the winter, street maintenance services.
